We have reviewed our responsibility to designate a Data Protection Representative and have documented the findings; the contact details of our DPR (if applicable) will be recorded on our privacy notice that we provide to all data subjects at the point when they provide us with their personal data.

We have conducted recent risk assessments of our organisational and technological data processing activities under the guidance of a third party, and have committed to a change plan to ensure all security measures surrounding personal data are adequate and appropriate.
